About the Network

The Upper Murray Regional Neighbourhood House Network (UMRNHN) is one of 16 networks working with neighbourhood houses across rural, regional and metropolitan Victoria. The Networks are funded to provide governance and operational support and resources to their member neighbourhood houses and centres. Networks also have a facilitative and advocacy role, enabling their members to participate in broader community strategies and discussions.

In the Upper Murray Region there are six Local Government Areas: Indigo, Wodonga, Wangaratta, Moira, Alpine and Towong. These municipalities include large regional centres, small towns and villages, and semi-rural and rural areas. There are 16 funded neighbourhood houses in the Upper Murray, all of which are members of the UMRNHN.

The Network provides members with a range of services, including governance and operational support for committees and staff, advice on community development, and capacity building and links. The Network also actively seeks funding to delivery Network-wide projects that will build the capacity of our members to work in emerging priority areas, such as the reduction of loneliness and isolation, and building community resilience.

This resource was originally developed as part of the *Behind the Scenes at the Neighbourhood House* project funded by the Victorian Responsible Gambling Foundation through their Prevention Partnership Program.

The project aimed to reduce gambling related harm by creating opportunities for people to connect and participate in community activities as an alternative to gambling, and by reducing loneliness and social isolation, both risk factors in gambling related harm.

Purpose of this guide

This resource is designed to give service providers working with clients in the Upper Murray region information about community-based, local activities offered by neighbourhood houses.

These activities range in cost from free to fee for service. Clients can be referred and supported to participate in these activities where appropriate.

Why refer to a neighbourhood house?

Neighbourhood houses (also known as neighbourhood centres, community centres, community houses, learning centres and community learning centres) are well recognised by the Victorian Government as playing an important role in building vibrant communities through a unique structure and community development approach.

They are identified as being significant places of inclusion, providing valuable social, recreational, educational and training opportunities. They are welcoming, non-threatening places, where anyone can come to meet new people, contribute to their community, get helpful information and learn new skills. They connect people through their diverse volunteering roles, and through their programs, services, information, support and community activities.

Programs offered are diverse, and include:

- Community meals
- Community transport
- Exercise
- Health and wellbeing
- Music
- Art and craft
- Family support programs
- Vocational education and training

- Literacy and numeracy training
- Emergency preparedness
- Environmental sustainability
- Indigenous and CALD cultural activities
- School holiday programs
- Playgroups and childcare
- Youth groups

Some neighbourhood houses also provide services such as Centrelink and VicRoads. Several run social enterprises.

Although neighbourhood houses differ from each other in many ways, they are united by the Neighbourhood House Sector Framework and therefore aim to:

- assist community members to make their communities fairer and more sustainable with the resources, services and infrastructure they need
- empower communities to have more control over their own destiny
- encourage personal growth, self-help and the sharing of knowledge


